- What it does: NewsPal saves websites to read and jump from article to article offline
- Free to download articles up to 200 MB
- 6 additional download subscription tiers
- Bronze - Up to 500 MB Monthly - \$0.99 USD
- Bronze - Up to 500 MB Annually - \$7.99 USD
- Gold - Up to 2 GB Monthly - \$1.99 USD
- Gold - Up to 2 GB Annually - \$15.99 USD
- Platinum - Up to 10 GB Monthly - \$3.99 USD
- Platinum - Up to 10 GB Annually - \$29.99 USD

### What makes it different:

- Saves entire websites so you can pick what to read later
- Saves articles and any articles linked to it
- Scheduler: automatically downloads your websites each day so you can read later
- Scheduler remembers what time you leave wifi and schedules to finish downloading before you're offline
- Saves articles ad-free
- Bypass Soft-Paywall
- No login required, No personal data collected

How to Use (also available in app and the photos file in Press Kit)

1. Download from App Store
2. Go to a website you like or an article you'd like to read

3. Tap the share button on the bottom of your screen
4. To allow NewsPal to be Shareable - Swipe left, tap “More”, tap “edit”, tap the plus sign next to NewsPal, tap “done”
5. Tap the share button, then tap on the NewsPal Icon
6. Open NewsPal, from here you can read more about the app or tap the “X” button in the upper left corner to begin using
7. Tap “Update” next to the article you saved
8. Tap on the article to begin reading!
